

Call for Donations for the Acquisition of 25 Electrocardiograms

Hôtel-Dieu de France (HDF) is a prestigious, Lebanese non-profit academic medical Center, operated by the Saint Joseph University of Beirut. Established in 1923, HDF was founded 35 years after the creation of the Faculty of Medicine at Saint Joseph University, marking a significant milestone in the healthcare landscape of Lebanon.

Quality is a fundamental principle in the management of Hôtel-Dieu de France, guiding the efforts of all medical, care, and administrative professionals in their dedication to patient service.

In this context, HDF seeks to renew and modernize its essential medical equipment. One of the critical tools for patient care is the electrocardiogram (ECG), which is used daily in all hospital departments to diagnose and monitor heart conditions.



■ **PROJECT TITLE:**

Acquisition of 25 New Electrocardiograms.

■ **APPLICANT:**

The cardiology Department of Hôtel-Dieu de France, an academic medical Center of Saint Joseph University of Beirut, under the leadership of Professor Rabi Azar. Each year, 25,600 ECGs are performed at the hospital.

■ **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The electrocardiograms currently in use, although functional, need to be replaced by more advanced and efficient devices. The acquisition of new ECG machines will lead to a significant improvement in diagnosis and patient monitoring while ensuring better care.



■ OBJECTIVES:

- Improve the quality of care by providing state-of-the-art equipment that is more accurate and faster.
- Facilitate the work of medical staff with ergonomic and intuitive devices.
- Increase the diagnostic and monitoring capacity for high-risk patients.
- Ensure optimal patient care by reducing wait times and improving the accuracy of diagnoses.

■ IMPACT:

- **Patients:** will benefit from faster and more reliable diagnoses, which are essential for effective management of cardiovascular diseases.
- **Doctors and caregivers:** will have access to modern equipment that simplifies their work and improves the speed and accuracy of diagnoses.
- **All hospital departments:** the new ECG machines will be used throughout the hospital's medical services to meet the growing needs of patients.

■ COST AND BUDGET:

We plan to acquire electrocardiograms at a unit price of **3,500 USD**.
