

## ***Call for Support for the Acquisition of 14 New Operating Tables***

Hôtel-Dieu de France (HDF) is a prestigious, Lebanese non-profit academic medical center, operated by the Saint Joseph University of Beirut (USJ). Established in 1923, HDF was founded 35 years after the creation of the Faculty of Medicine at Saint Joseph University, marking a significant milestone in the healthcare landscape of Lebanon.

Quality is a fundamental principle in the management of Hôtel-Dieu de France, guiding the efforts of all medical, care, and administrative professionals in their dedication to patient service.

As part of our commitment to providing cutting-edge medical care, HDF needs to modernize its surgical equipment. One of the priorities of this initiative is the acquisition of new operating tables, which are essential for the successful execution of surgical procedures.



## ■ PROJECT TITLE:

Acquisition of 14 New Operating Tables.

## ■ APPLICANT:

The operating room of Hôtel-Dieu de France, the university hospital of Saint Joseph University of Beirut, under the direction of Professor Fadi Ferran. Each year, 8280 general surgeries and 716 cardiovascular surgeries are performed in this operating room.

## ■ PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The current operating tables, although functional and operational, need to be replaced with more modern ones. We plan to transfer these tables to other hospitals within the HDF network, where they can continue to be used. The acquisition of new tables will help us maintain our level of excellence in surgical care.





## ■ OBJECTIVES:

- Improve the working conditions of surgical teams by providing modern and ergonomic equipment.
- Optimize patient care with high-tech tools, thereby reducing surgical complications.
- Increase the hospital's capacity to meet the growing demand for surgical procedures.

## ■ IMPACT:

- **Patients:** will benefit from significant improvements in operating conditions and better clinical outcomes.
- **Surgical Teams:** will have access to modern tools that facilitate their daily work, enhancing the precision and safety of procedures.
- **Other Hospitals in the HDF Network:** will receive the older tables, still functional and operational, strengthening their ability to provide quality surgical care.
- **The Entire Medical Community:** an optimized environment, reducing risks for both patients and medical staff (over 850 surgical procedures per month).

## ■ COST AND BUDGET:

We plan to acquire operating tables at a unit price of **65,500 USD**.

The current need is for 14 tables.
