

Call for Support for the Acquisition of Two Complete Anesthesia Machines

Hôtel-Dieu de France (HDF) is a prestigious, Lebanese non-profit academic medical center, operated by the Saint Joseph University of Beirut (USJ). Established in 1923, HDF was founded 35 years after the creation of the Faculty of medicine at Saint Joseph University, marking a significant milestone in the healthcare landscape of Lebanon.

Quality is a fundamental principle in the management of Hôtel-Dieu de France, guiding the efforts of all medical, care, and administrative professionals in their dedication to patient service.

In pursuit of continuous excellence, HDF is launching a critical initiative aimed at modernizing its anesthesiology equipment. One of the top priorities of this initiative is the acquisition of two state-of-the-art, complete anesthesia machine vital tools to ensure the highest standards of surgical and anesthetic care and to provide optimal patient management.

■ PROJECT TITLE:

Acquisition of two complete anesthesiology machines.

■ APPLICANT:

The anesthesiology-reanimation Department of Hôtel-Dieu de France, under the leadership of Professor Samia Jebara. The hospital performs over 850 surgeries requiring anesthesia each month.

■ PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The anesthesiology equipment currently in use, although functional and operational, has reached a stage where renewal is essential. We plan to transfer this equipment to other hospitals in the HDF Hospital network, which will still be able to benefit from it. The acquisition of new, modern, high-performance equipment will enable us to maintain our level of excellence in surgical care and anesthesia.



■ OBJECTIVES:

- Improve working conditions for anesthesiology teams with modern, reliable and ergonomic equipment.
- Guarantee optimal patient care, thereby reducing the risks associated with anesthesia.
- Strengthen the hospital's ability to meet the growing demand for surgical procedures, with 850 operations performed per month.



■ IMPACT:

With approximately 850 surgical procedures performed every month, Hôtel-Dieu de France must provide state-of-the-art equipment. The acquisition of new anesthesiology machines will contribute to:

- **Improve patient care:**
by guaranteeing safer, more effective anesthesia.
- **Enhance the efficiency of medical teams:**
by providing them with modern, high-performance equipment, facilitating surgical procedures and improving working conditions.
- **Support hospitals in the HDF network:**
by redistributing older equipment that is still functional and operational, thus strengthening their ability to provide quality surgical care.

■ COST AND BUDGET:

We plan to acquire two complete anesthesia machines, each with an estimated cost of **66,000 USD**.
